

RERTR 2008 — 30^{TH} INTERNATIONAL MEETING ON REDUCED ENRICHMENT FOR RESEARCH AND TEST REACTORS OCTOBER 5-9, 2008

Announcement and Call for Papers

The U.S. Department of Energy / National Nuclear Security Administration's Office of Global Threat Reduction is hosting the "RERTR 2008 International Meeting on Reduced Enrichment for Research and Test Reactors" in cooperation with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA). The meeting is being organized by Argonne National Laboratory and will be held in Washington, D.C. USA from October 5-9, 2008. This will be the 30th annual meeting in a series on the same general subject regarding the conversion of reactors within the Global Threat Reduction Initiative (GTRI).

Information will be exchanged on the progress of national and international programs to develop low-enriched uranium (LEU) fuels and targets for research and test reactors and to convert research reactors and radioisotope production processes to the use of such fuels and targets. The meeting technical subjects will include development of new LEU fuels, development and testing of LEU targets and processes for the production of Mo-99, design and safety analyses for reactor conversions, transportation and storage of spent fuels, and HEU minimization and Global Threat Reduction. The meeting will be held in English and will be open to those who share such interests, but the organizers reserve the right to limit the attendance. Technical and policy experts interested in attending the conference may register by completing the attached forms.

Participants interested in such technical topics are encouraged to present a paper at the meeting. Additionally, papers submitted by university students participating in GTRI activities are welcome and will be included in the Poster Session. Please indicate an intention to submit a paper by completing the attached Abstract Submittal form (Attachment 2) and send the completed form with an abstract of the paper, as soon as possible, but not later than **July 15, 2008**, to Linda Legerski, whose address is enclosed at the end of this announcement. The presentation of each paper will be limited to 20 minutes.

It is the intent of the organizers to collect the finished papers and release authorizations by **August 1, 2008** to allow time to prepare CDs containing the papers for distribution at the meeting. The papers must be submitted in a timely manner for this to be accomplished. Several reminders will be sent prior to the deadline to remind authors to submit their full papers on time. All papers will be published on the RERTR web site (www.rertr.anl.gov) following the meeting.

Meeting Venue

The RERTR 2008 International Meeting will be held at the **Hamilton Crowne Plaza Hotel** located at 14th and K Streets, NW, Washington, D.C. The hotel utilizes the Grand Ballroom and meeting facilities of **The Sphinx Club at Almas Temple**, which is located immediately adjacent to the hotel at 1315 K Street, NW. The Hamilton Crowne Plaza and The Sphinx Club at Almas Temple are both located one block north of the McPherson Square Metro Station (Orange and Blue Lines).

The Hamilton Crowne Plaza is making available two blocks of rooms for the meeting. On a first-come, firstserved basis, a block of 60 rooms is available at the U.S. government rate of \$201 USD per night for either single or double rooms. (Breakfast is not included in the room rate.) Please note that registrants do not have to be U.S. government employees to take advantage of the government rate; it is available to all. Once the rooms from the first block are exhausted, a second block of 75 rooms is available for \$259 USD per night for either single or double rooms. Early reservations are recommended as a limited number of rooms have been blocked for RERTR 2008 at the Hamilton Crowne Plaza. Registrants must identify themselves as being with the **RERTR 2008 International Meeting – Group Code AGO** and ask for the special meeting rate. Reservation requests must be made by the close of business on **September 12, 2008** to qualify for the group rates. Reservations made after that date will be confirmed upon availability and booked at the standard price. <u>The</u> <u>arranged rates provide an exceptional value for downtown Washington, D.C. during this time of year</u>.



ABSTRACT (12 PT, BOLD, ALL CAPS)

Your paper must be in English. It should start with a short abstract of 150 words describing the key elements of your contribution and its conclusions. This paragraph should be typeset in block mode, 10 pt, with left and right indents of .5 in.

1. Introduction (12 Pt, bold)

Your paper should then continue on the same page with an introduction. For these main sections the size is 12 pt, single line spacing with a spacing of 0 pt before and after the paragraph mark, and the lines are justified in block mode. Please use 1 in. top, bottom, left, and right on $8\frac{1}{2}\times11$ paper; for authors using A4 paper, please use standard margins.

Additional sections should follow on the experimental set-up, results, their discussion, conclusions, acknowledgements and references.

2. Page Numbering

Please do not number the pages of your paper.

3. Tables and Figures

Tables, black and white or color figures should be inserted into the text at the appropriate place in publication quality. They should be centered and figures should be identified with a caption.

Note: All photographs and figures that are not in electronic format should be scanned into your paper at 300 dpi in BMP or JPEG format. If you are unable to scan such photographs and figures, please provide original images along with the text and tables of your paper to the registration desk at the meeting.

4. References

Please number your references and cite them in brackets [1]. The list of references should be at the very end of your paper under the section heading "References".


