It is with deep regret that we are informing you of the cancellation of the 2013-RERTR International Meeting, which was scheduled to be held October 27-30, 2013 in Chicago, IL. Our decision is a direct consequence of the U.S. government shutdown that began on October 1, 2013. Despite the best efforts of Argonne National Laboratory and Global Threat Reduction Initiative's (GTRI) Reactor Conversion Program, we cannot overcome the impact of a U.S. government shutdown on planning and hosting this important meeting.

Despite cancellation of this meeting, we remain strongly committed to our collective efforts to minimize the use of HEU in civilian application around the world. We very much appreciate your patience and understanding on this decision. We will continue to keep you informed as we develop the path forward.
